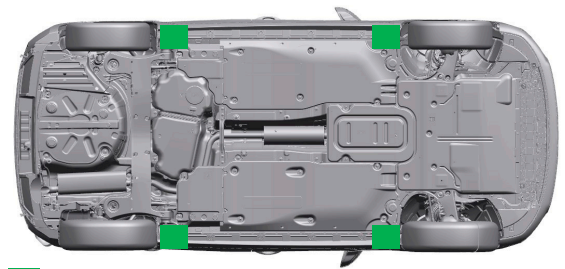
2. Immobilisation / stabilisation / lifting

Immobilise the vehicle

1. Engage a gear in vehicles with a manual gearbox (a) or select the "P" position in vehicles with an automatic gearbox (b).
2. Engage the parking brake (c).
3. Switch off the ignition (see Chapter 3).
4. Secure the vehicle to prevent it from moving.



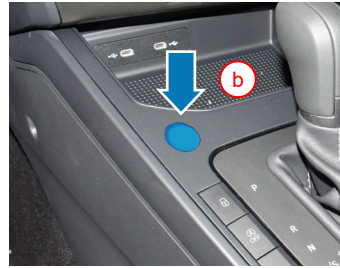

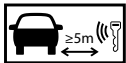

Switch off ignition

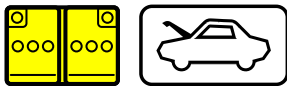


1. Remove the ignition key (a)
2. If the vehicle is equipped with "Keyless-Entry" - Press the START - ENGINE - STOP button (b) on the central console, without pressing the brake pedal.

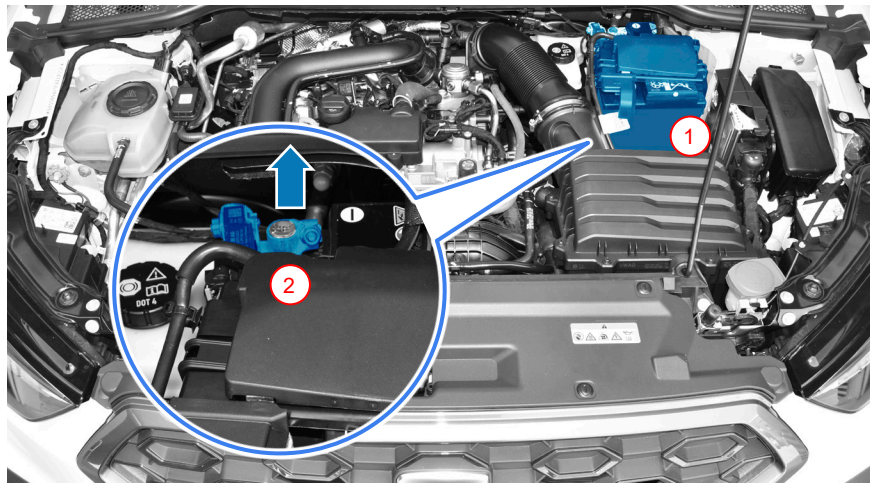


Keep the vehicle key and/or smartphone app further than 5 m away from the vehicle.

Disconnecting the 12-volt battery



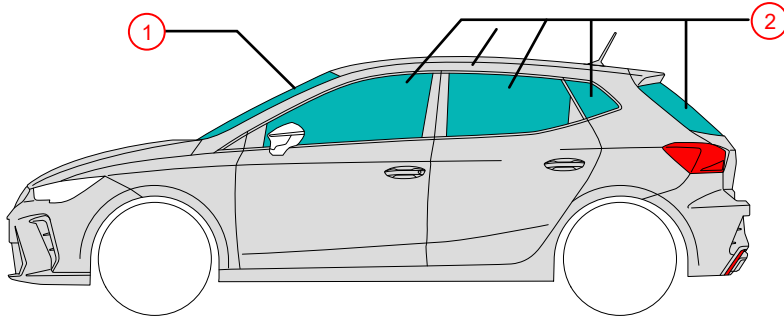
1. Locate the 12 V battery located on the left side of the engine compartment.
2. Disconnect the negative terminal of the battery from the onboard network.

5. Stored energy / liquids / gases / solids



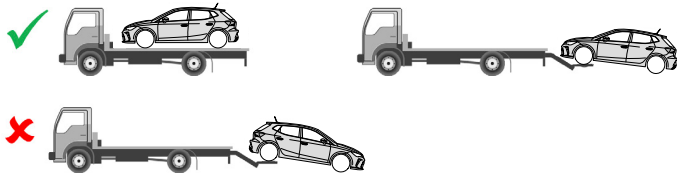
6. In case of fire
